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Hyannis Main Street Business Improvement District (BID)



What is a Business Improvement District (BID)?

BIDs are special assessment districts, enabled by Mass. General Laws
Chapter 40 (0) and sanctioned by the local legislative body; fees are binding. BIDs across the country have been successful in revitalizing downtowns because they are funded by the property owners within the district who provide a dependable revenue stream.

The Hyannis Main Street Business Improvement District (HMSBID) is a private nonprofit organization that was established in 1999 in response to the need to carry out a Hyannis Renaissance. The Board of Directors is comprised of property owners and tenants who are geographically distributed and represent the property owners and all business aspects of the district.

The mission of the Hyannis Main Street Business Improvement District is to promote the community and economic development of the Main Street, Hyannis district as a desirable place to live, work, invest, and visit.

















BID PRIORITIES



Safety & Security

We advocated for the expansion of the Community Service Officers program, increased street lighting, and remove graffiti tags on a regular basis.



We plant and maintain 140 planters, our daily Clean Team keeps the street clean, we recently added globe lights to trees.

Marketing & Events

We send out a monthly newsletter and regular e-blasts, maintain highly engaged social media accounts, and host/support a number of events, including First Fridays, Long Table, and the Holiday Stroll.

Capital Improvements

We recently supported a streetscape improvement plan, and work with the town on long term wayfinding, housing, and beautification efforts.



Grants

In 2022, we oversaw \$210,000 in grant funding to improve Main Street businesses, including a façade grant program with the town and state.

Business, Community & Government Relations

We attend regular state TDI and BID meetings, town council meetings, support housing in the downtown, and recently supported downtown zoning changes.
